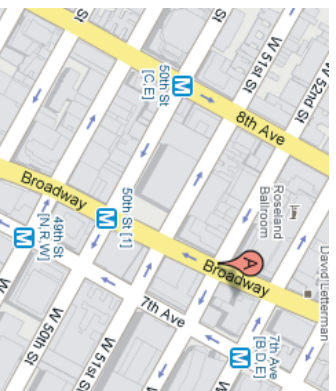

What is SMI-NY? SMI-NY is not a remedial nor an advanced mathematics program. It is a provocative and dynamic way for your child to engage in the revolutionary and preposterous world of mathematics using the vibrant culture of New York City as a backdrop, while utilizing the tools of web 2.0 technology, including virtual networking, blogs, wikis and podcasts.

Who should attend SMI-NY? Our program is for children who will be in middle school (5th - 8th grade) in the fall of 2009. Please contact us if your child is outside this age range.

Where and when will SMI-NY meet? Our program runs from 9 am to 3 pm and meets on the campus of the St Thomas Choir School, which is located at 202 West 58th Street, just one block from Columbus Circle. During the day, we will be roaming the 5 boroughs via subway and city bus.

Who are the instructors? SMI-NY is a collaboration between Robert M Berkman and Haydee Von Sternberg. Mr. Berkman has 25 years of experience teaching mathematics in New York's private and public schools. He has taught workshops to teachers around the country and his papers have been published in professional journals. Ms. von Sternberg is the Lower School Math Coordinator at the Chapin School and has worked with thousands of children in her long career.

Why should my child participate? By participating in this program, your child will learn that mathematics is an important and pervasive part of the fabric of our daily life. S/he will learn to use the mathematical tools to understand how New York City works, and will develop an appreciation for big mathematical ideas and their applications. In the process, your child will develop a comfort with mathematics and see that it can be a friendly and useful way of thinking.

How much does it cost? A full 3 week program is \$1500, but we offer 1 and 2 week programs for \$600 (\$500 for the week of June 29 - July 2.) You may sign up for any 1, 2 or all 3 weeks. All transportation and admission costs are included in the fee, as well as snacks. Your child should bring lunch.
